1. A _____ Name

“This, then, is how you should pray: ‘Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name....’” Matthew 6:9 (NIV, 2011)

2. An _____ Name

“Moses said to God, ‘Suppose I go to the Israelites and say to them, ‘The God of your fathers has sent me to you,’ and they ask me, ‘What is his name?’ Then what shall I tell them?’” Exodus 3:13 (NIV, 2011)

3. A _____ Name

“God said to Moses, ‘I AM WHO I AM. This is what you are to say to the Israelites: ‘I AM has sent me to you.’”” Exodus 3:14 (NIV, 2011)

4. An _____ Name

“God also said to Moses, ‘Say to the Israelites, ‘The LORD, the God of your fathers—the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac and the God of Jacob—has sent me to you. This is my name forever, the name you shall call me from generation to generation.’”” Exodus 3:15 (NIV, 2011)

1. How would you define the word, “holy”?
2. Read Exodus 3:13-14. Why might the people held captive in Egypt ask Moses about the name of God?
3. The name that God reveals to Moses in this translation is “I AM WHO IM AM”, or simply “I AM”. This name is based on four Hebrew letters that are commonly rendered into English as “Yahweh”, or “Jehovah”. Why would God reveal a name that simply means something like, “I AM”?
4. Read Matthew 6:9. Why is it important for God to keep His name holy among us?
